WHAT'S ON TAP

The Ouachita Lions will travel to play the Central-Baton Rouge Wildcats in a Class 5A regional playoff game. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m., and admission is \$9

LAST MEETING

Ouachita and Central last played during the first round of the 1997 playoffs. Ouachita won that matchup, 39-6.

LAST TIME ON THE FIELD

Ouachita played host to West Jefferson in a Class 5A first-round game, and Ouachita won, 27-13. ... Central played host to New Iberia, and Central won, 56-14.

OUACHITA'S GAME RECAP

West Jefferson took a 7-0 lead on a long TD pass, but Ouachita came right back as Jameel Chatman returned the ensuing kickoff 91 yards for a TD with 8:12 left in the first quarter. Garrett Brown had 1-yard TD run in the first quarter to give Ouachita a 13-7 lead that stood up at halftime. Neither team scored again until the fourth quarter when Brown had 1-yard TD run with 11:20 remaining. West Jefferson cut the lead to 20-13, but QB Quentin Wheeler scored on a 5-yard TD run with 5:21 to play. Wheeler finished with 12 carries for 100 yards. The Ouachita defense had 10 sacks and held West Jefferson to minus-25 yards rushing.

COACHES CORNER

Coach John Carr is in his fifth season as head coach of the Lions. Carr has a 43-19 overall record at Ouachita. The Lions have advanced to the playoffs in each of Carr's seasons as head coach, reaching the Class 4A semifinals in 2005, the 4A quarterfinals in 2006, the 5A first round in 2007, and the 5A quarterfinals in 2008.

COACH TALK

Coach Carr on Central: "We have to do a good job offensively and play defense with our offense. We can't give them a lot of possessions and get in a track meet with these guys. We can't have three turnovers like we did last week, and we can't have thirteen penalties like we did last week."

WHEELER POSES DUAL THREAT FOR OPPONENTS

Ouachita QB Quentin Wheeler ran 12 times for 100 yards and a TD last week, the third time he has rushed for at least 100 yards in a game this season. He is the team's rushing leader with 668 yards and has nine TDs. Wheeler was also 4-of-6 passing for 46 yards last week. On the season, he has passed for 1,256 yards with 12 TDs and four interceptions.

Ouachita PLAYERS TO WATCH

RB Ricky McCarthy has rushed for 661 yards and 10 TDs. ... FB Garrett Brown has come on strong late in the season with some power running and has three TDs in the last two games. ... WR Justin Ginyard leads the team with 26 receptions for 544 yards and six TDs. ... DL Elijah Sullivan has recorded 4.5 sacks in the last two weeks. He has 7.5 sacks and 38 tackles on the year.

DEFENSE SPARKS OUACHITA STREAK

Ouachita has won five consecutive games since a 43-12 loss to West Monroe in week six, and the defense has helped spark the success. Over the last five games, Ouachita has allowed just 40 points. One of those scores was an interception return, so the defense has given up just 33 points, an average of 6.6 points per game. Over the last three games, the Lions have recorded 22 sacks and held the three opponents to minus-41 yards on the ground on 67 carries.

LIONS HAVE YOUTH ON THEIR SIDE

Young players are playing big roles after Ouachita graduated 34 seniors from last year's team that reached the state quarterfinals. Underclassmen have scored 41 of Ouachita's 52 touchdowns this season.

BELL TAKES TOLL ON OPPOSING OFFENSES

Junior LB Terron Bell has been a driving force behind Ouachita's defense all season, and he leads the team in almost every major defensive category. Bell has 82.5 tackles, 13 tackles for losses, 8.5 sacks, four fumble recoveries, three forced fumbles, and two defensive touchdowns.

GROUND GAME GETS LIONS GOING

Ouachita ran for 248 yards last week in its win over West Jefferson. During their five-game winning streak, the Lions have gained 208 or more yards rushing in four out of five games and are averaging 221.8 yards per game.

SCOUTING THE CENTRAL WILDCATS

No. 4 seed Central-Baton Rouge brings some high-profile people and eye-popping numbers into its regional playoff matchup with Ouachita. Central is coached by Sid Edwards, who was named the Class 5A Coach of the Year last season by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association. WR Shedrick Davis was named first team All-State last season, and QB Will Briscoe was an honorable mention All-State selection. The Wildcats, led offensively by Briscoe and his brother Wes, average 48.6 points per game and allow just 13.5 points per game. Will Briscoe has thrown for 2,601 yards with 34 TDs and just two interceptions. Wes Briscoe has 48 receptions for 1,036 yards and 18 TDs.

Week 12 Quick Hits

- Ouachita Coach John Carr on Central's offense: They're scary. They are probably one of the most explosive teams we've played this year. They have an accurate quarterback, three good receivers, and a good running back. They throw and catch as good as anybody. They're in synch, and they haven't had a bad week yet."
- Ouachita quarterback Quentin Wheeler reached the 100-yard rushing mark for the third time this season.
- Ouachita's victory over West Jefferson was its fifth win in a row, its longest streak of the season.
- Ouachita recorded ten sacks against West Jefferson and another five tackles for losses. The Lions have 22 sacks over their last three games.
- West Jefferson's 76-yard TD pass in the first quarter last week was the first TD that the Ouachita defense had allowed in 11 quarters.
- The Ouachita offense has gained more than 400 yards in six of 11 games this season.
- Ouachita has scored at least 30 points in seven games this season and 40 or more points in five of ten games.
- Ouachita has held its opponents to single-digit scoring six times in 11 games.
- Central advanced to the Class 5A semifinals before losing to eventual state champion Destrehan, 21-14. It was the first time that Central had been as far as the semifinals since the 1970s.
- Central Coach Sid Edwards won two state titles when he was the head coach at Redemptorist. His teams won the 2002 3A title and the 2003 4A title.
- Ouachita has 23 seniors on this year's team after graduating 34 from the 2008 squad that reached the Class 5A quarterfinals.
- So far this season, Ouachita is 3-2 on the road and 5-1 at home.
- Including the playoffs, Ouachita was 6-2 at home last season with losses to Neville and West Monroe. The Lions were 4-1 on the road with the lone loss to West Monroe in the Class 5A quarterfinals.
- Ouachita won its only football state championship in 1989. Glenn Ellis, who quarterbacked Ouachita to the 1989 title, is now an assistant coach for Ouachita.
