The No. 10 seed Ouachita Lions will play at the No. 7 seed Carencro Bears on Friday in the second round of the Class 5A state playoffs. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

LAST MEETING

Carencro and Ouachita last met on the football field in 1996. Carencro won that matchup, 10-7.

Ouachita defeated New Iberia, 47-22. ... Carencro defeated Natchitoches-Central, 77-28.

WEEK 10 RECAP

Ouachita used a balanced offensive attack to upend No. 23 seed New Iberia in the first round of the Class 5A playoffs. The

Ouachita led 24-14 at the half, and New Iberia threatened to close the gap in the third quarter when Ouachita made a big defensive play. Will Ward intercepted a pass and raced 100 yards for a TD and a 30-14 Ouachita lead.

John Carr is in his seventh season as head coach of the Ouachita Parish football team. Carr has an overall record of 62-24 (.721). The Lions have advanced to the state playoffs in each of Carr's previous six seasons.

OPHS OFFENSIVE, DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Junior WR Taijuan Thomas and senior LB Will Ward were named the Ouachita Players of the Week on the postgame radio show following last week's contest against New Iberia. Thomas recorded career bests of 8 catches in a game and 157 receiving yards in a game. His performance included an 81-yard TD reception. Ward intercepted a pass in the third quarter and returned it 100 yards for a TD. He also had 8 total tackles.

OUACHITA PLAYERS TO WATCH

Senior RB Damarkus Sledge ran for 105 yards and a TD last week, his fifth 100-yard rushing game of the season. Sledge has 798 rushing yards and 8 TDs on the season. ... Senior PK/P T.J. Kijak made two field goals last week and has four on the season, including a long kick of 48 yards. Kijak also has put 72.3 percent of his kickoffs into the end zone for touchbacks. ... Senior LB Xavier Davis turned in a dual role last week with some time at RB. Davis ran the ball six times for 31 yards and two TDs. This season, Davis is second on the team in tackles with 68. ... Senior DE Jemarcus Marshall leads the Lions in tackles on the season with 73.5. He also has 9.5 tackles for losses. ... Junior DE Caleb Tucker has 65.5 tackles, 5.5 sacks, 11.5 tackles for losses, and 12 QB hurries this season.

WHEELER DRIVES OUACHITA DUAL-THREAT ATTACK

Ouachita senior quarterback Quentin Wheeler poses a threat for opponents through the air and on the ground as the leader of Ouachita's multi-faceted offense. Wheeler has completed 96-of-146 passes for 1,593 yards and 15 TDs this season to go along with 812 yards and 12 TDs on the ground. Wheeler has also caught a TD pass. Wheeler has 2,461 total offensive yards.

Wheeler's performance last week included 241 yards passing and a TD along with 68 yards and a TD on the ground. That effort pushed him past the 4,500-yard passing mark for his career and the 7,000-yard mark for career total offense. Wheeler needs 37 yards total offense to surpass 2,500 for the season. He also needs 188 yards rushing for his second 1,000-yard rushing season and one more rushing TD to reach 40 for his career. Wheeler also needs 3 TDs to reach 90 total for his career.

THOMAS ENJOYS BANNER JUNIOR SEASON

Junior WR Taijuan Thomas recorded single-game bests in receptions (8) and receiving yards (157) last week to continue to boost his career-best totals in receptions, yards, and TDs. Last week's performance, which included an 81-yard TD reception, raised his season totals to 45 catches for 759 yards and 8 TDs. Thomas averages 16.9 yards per catch and is third on the team in scoring with 54 points. Thomas has five kickoff returns for a 24.6 average, including a 75-yard TD return.

Media Quick Hits

- Coach John Carr on Carencro RB Alex Johnson: “He has great vision, balance, and his legs never stop moving. He is always fighting for extra yards and seldom goes down with first contact.”
- Carr on stopping Carencro’s potent running game: “We must tackle well. We have to get some penetration to disrupt their running game.”
- Ouachita is 4-0 on the road this season and 5-2 at home. Last season, Ouachita was 5-2 at home and 5-0 on the road. Ouachita has not lost a road game since the second round of the 2009 playoffs, a streak of nine games.
- Ouachita scored 368 points and allowed just 99 points in 10 regular-season games. Over the last five seasons, that is the most points scored and the fewest points allowed by a Ouachita team. The previous best for points scored was 350 in 2010. The previous best for fewest points allowed during that time was 145 in 2008.
- Ouachita has allowed just six passing TDs all season.
- Ouachita has used some big plays to reach the end zone. Of the 58 TDs the Lions have scored in 11 games this season, 19 have been from 40 yards or longer and 11 have been at least 60 yards.
- Ouachita has rushed for more than 350 yards in a game three times this season.
- Ouachita has scored at least 35 points in seven of 11 games this season and has reached at least 40 points six times. The Lions are averaging 37.7 points per game.
- Ouachita’s record is good when the Lions score first in games. Ouachita has scored first in 10 games this season and won nine of those games. Ouachita scored first in 9-of-12 games in 2010 and won eight of those games.
- Since John Carr became Ouachita’s head coach in 2005, the Lions have advanced to at least the second round of the playoffs six times in seven seasons. The Lions have reached at least the state quarter-finals four times under Carr.
- Ouachita finished the 2010 regular season 9-1, the first time the school’s football team has achieved that feat since 1994. In the 1994 playoffs, Ouachita advanced to the Superdome and finished as the state runner-up.
- Ouachita returns two first-team all-district players from 2010 — QB Quentin Wheeler and PK T.J. Kijak. Second-team all-district returnees are WR Taijuan Thomas and CB Javanta Henderson. Honorable mention selections coming back are WR Devaughn Sanders, DL Caleb Tucker, and LB Xavier Davis.
- Several new coaches have joined the Ouachita coaching staff since last season. Jerry Beach, Lloyd Fenske, Kyle Morace, Ryan Norris, Alex Sikes, Dean Smith, and David Taylor are all new to the OPHS football coaching staff.

CARENCRO BEARS QUICK FACTS

Carencro runs a wing-T offense that has churned out some big yards on the ground. The Bears have rushed for 3,957 yards for an average of 359.7 yards per game. Carencro averages 8.2 yards per carry and has 62 rushing TDs on the season. ... Carencro plays in District 3-5A. The Bears finished in a three-way tie for first place in district with Acadiana and Barbe. ... Carencro's lone loss of the season was at defending 5A champion Acadiana, 32-14. Since that loss, Carencro has outscored its three opponents by a combined score of 167-66. ... Carencro has scored less than 35 points just twice in 11 games — the loss to Acadiana and a 28-14 win over Barbe. ... Carencro and Ouachita have faced one common opponent this season in Natchitoches-Central. Ouachita won at Natchitoches 28-16 during the regular season. Carencro defeated Natchitoches 77-28 last week in the first round of the playoffs at Carencro. ... Carencro's playoff win last week was its first playoff win since the 2007 playoffs. ... Carencro makes a habit of jumping on its opponents early. The Bears have outscored the opposition 148-56 in the first quarter and 163-35 in the second quarter. ... The Bears have a turnover margin of +16 against its opponents.

CARENCRO OFFENSIVE PLAYERS TO WATCH

RB Alex Johnson has carried the ball 221 times for 2,296 yards and 32 TDs, breaking the single-season rushing record of former Carencro and LSU star Kevin Faulk. Johnson averaged 10.4 yards per carry, and he also has 7 receptions for 112 yards and a TD. Johnson has also returned 6 kickoffs for 207 yards, including a TD. ... QB Jalen Nixon has 101 carries for 685 yards and 12 TDs. Nixon has also completed 52-of-94 passes for 886 yards with 7 TDs and 2 interceptions. ... WR Shawn Thomas has 33 receptions for 506 yards and 5 TDs. He had 3 catches for 61 yards and a TD in last week's victory.

OTHER CARENCRO PLAYERS TO WATCH

DB Dillion Calais leads the team with 5 interceptions. ... P Cody Smith averages 33.1 yards per punt, but he has only punted 17 times this season. ... PK DJ Thomas has converted 1-of-2 field-goal attempts this season. His successful kick of 31 yards is his long attempt of the season. He has also made 60-of-61 PAT kicks.

LAST TIME OUT FOR THE BEARS

The Carencro running game was too much for Natchitoches-Central as the Bears rolled to a 77-28 victory at home in the first round of the Class 5A state playoffs.

Alex Johnson rushed 16 times for 264 yards and 3 TDs to lead the Bears and break Kevin Faulk's school single-season rushing record. Johnson's first three carries netted him 122 yards and a TD.

Natchitoches kept the game close early and was tied with the Bears at 14-14, but Carencro reeled off 42 unanswered points to take a 56-14 lead.

QB Jalen Nixon rushed 9 times for 60 yards and 2 TDs. He also completed 4-of-9 passes for 71 yards and a TD.
